We expect you to meet the Arthog conditions by:

- Recognising that all children have the right to freedom from abuse.
- Ensuring that all your staff, students and volunteers are carefully selected (with appropriate DBS clearance) and accept responsibility for helping to prevent the abuse of children in their care and at the Centre
- Responding swiftly and appropriately to all suspicions or allegations of abuse, by providing parents and children with the opportunity to voice any concerns they may have.
- Ensure the Designated Safeguarding Leads (DSL'S) from the school are contactable whilst a party from the school is at Arthog. The leader (of the party) will take specific responsibility for child and vulnerable adult safety and contact the DSL if needed and liaise with the Arthog Centre DSL.
- The school's DSL must inform Arthog's DSL of any issues of Child Protection and share concerns where appropriate.
- Ensuring access to confidential information is restricted to DSL's and the appropriate external authorities on a need to know basis.
- Reviewing the effectiveness of your group's Safeguarding Children Policy and Procedures, and working with external agencies in ensuring as far as is possible that children and vulnerable adults are protected
