Notice is hereby given that Borough of Telford & Wrekin in exercise of its powers Has Made an Order under Sections 32, 33, 35, 35A, 124 and Part III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with the Act.

- 1. The parking place subject to this Order ("the Parking Place") is located in Telford Town Centre and known as Hall Court Car Park.
- 2. The Telford and Wrekin Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2018 Hall Court Car Park will be revoked in its entirety.
- 3. This Order shall come into force on 4th day of November 2022, introduce arrangements for use of the Parking Place, introduce Initial Charges, maximum permitted parking periods and introduce Penalty Charges for contravention of this Order.
- 4. This Order shall introduce arrangements for use of the Parking Place, introduce Initial Charges, maximum permitted parking periods and introduce Penalty Charges for contravention of this Order.
- 5. From Monday to Saturday inclusive between 6am and 6pm of the initial charges in respect of a Vehicle or Trailer parked on the Parking Place at Hall Court Car Park are as follows:

Where a Vehicle or Trailer is parked for

(i) up to 2 hours - £1.60 (ii) up to 4 hours - £3.00 (iii) more than 4 hours - £4.00

- 6. From Monday to Saturday inclusive between midnight to 6am and from 6pm to midnight the initial charge in respect of a Vehicle or Trailer parked on the Parking Place at Hall Court Car Park is £0.50
- 7. Where a Vehicle or Trailer is parked for any length of time at any time on the Parking Place at Hall Court Car Park on a Sunday, the Initial Charge in respect of a Vehicle or Trailer is £1.50
- 8. The Driver of a Vehicle towing a Caravan into the Parking Place at Hall Court Car Park and the driver of a Motorhome shall not permit the Caravan or the Motorhome to wait in that Parking Place between the hours of 11pm to midnight and from midnight to 6am
- 9.
