Location

Bridleway at The Mount, Old Office Road

Commencing at the junction with adopted highway Old Office Road and bridleway 94 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SJ 68315 08254 the route proceeds in a general South by West direction for approximately 237 metres on a stone and natural surface with a width of 2 metres through a wooded area for approximately 237 metres to terminate at an unnamed adopted highway at OSGR SJ 68267 08046

Bridleway at The Mount, Old Office Road to Attwood Terrace

Commencing at the junction with adopted highway Old Office Road and bridleway 94 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SJ 68200 08136 the route proceeds in a general South by East direction on a tarmac surface with a width of 2 metres for approximately 275 metres to the adopted highway named Dawley Green Way at OSGR SJ 68329 07914 crossing Dawley Green Way to OSGR SJ 68341 07877 the route continues in the same general direction for approximately 261 metres to the junction with Blews Hill at OSGR SJ 68386 07698 where the route diverts towards Attwood Terrace terminating at OSGR SJ 68428 07643
