STATEMENT
MODIFICATION ORDER
FOOTPATH 25 DIVERSION ORDER
(PARISH OF CHETWYND)**

The above Order, made on 13 June 2024, if confirmed as made will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by diverting the footpath commencing at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SJ 69103 23176 the route being an undefined/unsurfaced path having a width of approximately 1 metre continuing in a north west direction for approximately 132 metres to a junction with the adopted highway at (OSGR) SJ 69025 23274 to commencing at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SJ 69103 23176 the route being an undefined/unsurfaced path having a width of approximately 1 metre continuing in a northerly direction for approximately 95 metres (OSGR) SJ 69129 23277 then continuing in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 94 metres to a junction with the adopted highway at (OSGR) SJ 69025 23274.

Limitations: 6ft metal gate at the junction with the adopted highway at (OSGR) SJ 69025 2327

This Order replaces the order previously made on the 20 April 2023 and advertised on 4 May 2023 known as Footpath 25 Diversion Order (Parish of Chetwynd) 2023.
