

# THE BOROUGH OF TELFORD & WREKIN COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, DOSELEY AND HORSEHAY) (PROVISION OF ROAD HUMPS) NOTICE 2024

The Council gives notice that under Section 90 of the Highways Act 1980 it proposes to install road humps of the following types at the following locations:

1	75 mm high, 1900 mm wide, 3000 mm long, SPEED CUSHION coloured Red and formed in rubber
2	65 mm high, 4800 mm wide, 4000 mm long, SPEED TABLE coloured Black and Red and formed in rubber
3	75 mm high, 4800 mm wide, 4000 mm long, SPEED TABLE coloured Red and formed in rubber

The existing 65mm high, 1600mm wide and 2000mm long speed cushions formed in black rubber on St Lukes Road will be removed, to be replaced with the speed tables listed above
