Pride in Your Community: Improvements in Your Area

Over the next three years an additional £45 million will be invested into improving the Borough's roads, pavements, street lights and structures. This includes the installation of energy efficient streetlights and road signs, a programme of road lining improvement as well as additional investment in repairing local roads and paths and environmental maintenance.

We will shortly be carrying out a patching scheme to improve the condition of the highway on Webb Crescent, Dawley. The work is due to take place in the next few weeks **but is not expected to take more than 2 week, weather permitting, to complete in your road**. Residents will be asked not to park on the highway during the works

Access will be maintained during the works for residents and for emergency vehicles although there will be short periods of time when the contractors will require residential and commercial traffic to be excluded to allow the surfacing material to harden

If you have any special access requirements while the works are in progress make them known to the site operatives. We will try to cause as little inconvenience as possible and would appreciate your co-operation whilst we are undertaking the works.
