Notice of Speed Limit Proposal
Telford and Wrekin Council (Holyhead Road, Wellington)
(Speed Limit) Order 2018

Notice is hereby given that Borough of Telford & Wrekin proposes to make the above named Order under Sections 82, 83 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order will be to

(1) Revoke the Trunk Roads (40mph SPEED LIMIT DIRECTION) (No14) ORDER 1962 in its entirety (2) Prohibit motor vehicles exceeding a speed of 30mph along the following length of road:

Holyhead Road, Wellington, Telford	From a point 152m west of the junction with Haygate Road, in an easterly direction, to a point 12m west of its junction with New Church Road.

(3) Prohibit motor vehicles exceeding a speed of 40mph along the following lengths of roads:

Forest Glen to Junction 7 M54, The Wrekin, Telford	From its junction with Holyhead Road B5061 to Cuddley, for a distance of 55m in a south westerly direction.
Holyhead Road, Wellington, Telford	From its junction with Holyhead Road B5061 to Cuddley, to a point 152m west of the junction with Haygate Road.
